New Projects Update

Perth WA – ISS Group Limited (ASX:ISS) is pleased to announce the award of several projects in the Middle East, Indonesia, Malaysia, Australia and India.

MAERSK OIL (Danish based energy company): ISS continues its partnership with Maersk Oil, via the award of the “On-Site Support Services” contract in Qatar which is being conducted in parallel with the Phase 1 Implementation of the Production Loss Accounting project previously announced.

Tanggung LNG (an LNG plant operated by BP in Indonesia): Following the implementation of the Hydrocarbon Value Realization (HVR) project, ISS has been awarded the “LNG Performance Monitoring” project, to monitor plant equipment against their operating envelopes. The project leverages the HVR solution deployed previously by ISS and highlights possible performance excursions.

Newfield Exploration Company (an independent crude oil and natural gas exploration and production company): ISS has been awarded the “Offshore Data Capture and Reporting” project for Newfield’s Peninsula Malaysia’s Chermingat, East Belumut and West Belumut field. The project will provide a web based data capture, validation, publication and reporting solution for the field and office.

It has provided a standardised way to capture, manage, communicate, search and distribute internal communications with and between shifts both remotely and onsite; streamlining their shift handover and reporting processes. Shift Log is an electronic replacement for operator log books. It is one of the additional ISS modules that

leverage the BabelFish infrastructure and provides an auditable, searchable, single point of reference for superintendents and operators to log and manage day to day communications*.
